Color, model of preference, operating nuts, upper rod, lower rod, support tube, support wheel, lower valve assembly, brake off barrel, drain tubes

- 2. Fire hydrant has a leak. Outside or inside the barrel? Common solutions
- 3. What if the operating nut is just spinning and the Hydrant cannot be opened or closed?
